Directions To Whipple Tree Farm

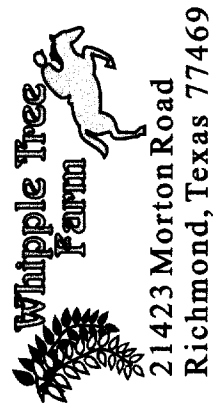
Take 45 South to I-10 (either via Beltway 8 or Loop 610). Go West on I-10 to Hwy 99 (Grand Parkway). Go South on 99 past Westheimer Pkwy., past Fry Rd. & past Westheimer Rd. (FM 1093). Go underneath Westpark Tollway. Go to West Bellfort St. (Stop light, look for Long Meadow subdivision) & turn right. WTF is about 1/4 mile on the left.

Cars: Please park in first pasture

Trailers: Please park in second pasture

CONCESSIONS: Available on premises
HARD HATS: Must be worn when mounted
EQUIPMENT: Martingales are not allowed in flat classes. Polo wraps are allowed in equitation and jumper classes only. Bell boots are allowed for jumper classes only, unless approved by the management/judge in case of inclement weather.

MEMBERSHIP: For a fee of \$15.00 per year riders (\$1.00 per horse) may become a member of S.J.H.S.A. to receive points towards year end awards (applications available).

Whipple Tree farm, Dianne Gallatin, and the S.J.H.S.A. Reserve the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising from any incident during the show without claims or damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in the rule regulations shall be decided by the show committee; their decision is final.

The horse show committee reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any awards without claim for damages. It also reserves the right to change or substitute courses to combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes.

Condition of Entry: Every horse entered for competition will be the control of the show Mgr., But WTF, Dianne Gallatin, nor the S.J.H.S.A. in no case will be responsible for any loss or damage which occur to any negligence on behalf of WTF or S.J.H.S.A..

Entries must be paid by open check prior to issuing number.

WARNING: Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

HOPEFUL JUMPER - Fences 2' - 2' 3". No cross entries in ring 2 divisions or other jumper divisions.

WALK/TROT EQUITATION - No cross entries into any other division. Year-end achievement certificate after one blue ribbon. Year-end medal after three blue ribbons.

PRE-BEGINNER EQUITATION - Fences 18". Trot or Canter four fences. For riders who have not won six blue ribbons at any show over fences. Year-end achievement certificate after one blue ribbon. Year-end medal after 3 blue ribbons.

BEGINNER EQUITATION - Fences 2'. With a course of twice around. No cross entries except pony division. For riders who have not shown over 2'. Last course may have one diagonal line. Grand & Reserve year-end award winners must advance.

ADULT BEGINNER - Fences 18". Open to adult riders over 18 years who have not shown over 18". Riders are eligible for entire show year. No cross entries into other divisions except flat classes.

NOVICE EQUITATION - Fences 2' 3". For riders who have not shown over 2' 6". Top four year-end award winners must advance next year. Riders are eligible for entire show year.

LIMIT HUNTER - Fences 2' 6". For riders who have not shown over 2' 9" at any show. Riders are eligible for entire current show year.

LIMIT EQUITATION - same rules - 1 flat, 1 O/F.

BABY GREEN HUNTER - Fences 2' 3" to 2' 6". Open to horses and ponies for current year only. No cross entries over 2' 6".

PONY HUNTER - Fences 2' to 2' 3". No in and outs. Open to ponies 14.2 and under ridden by junior riders.

SCHOOLING HUNTER - Fences 2' 6". Open to all.

JUNIOR / ADULT HUNTER - Fences 2' 9". Open to junior and amateur adults. **JUNIOR / ADULT EQUATION** - same

ADULT EQUITATION - Fences 2' to 2' 3". Simple figure 8 course. No in & outs. Open to all amateur adults 25 & over.

SCHOOLING JUMPER - Fences 2' 9" to 3' 0". Open to all. No cross entry into other jumper divisions.

OPEN JUMPER - Fences 3' to 3' 6". To start. No cross entries.

TRAINING JUMPER - Fences 2' 3" to 2' 6". No cross entries into other jumper divisions. During the year, if rider/ horse combination moves into another jumper division, they may not return to training jumper.
